LINDA HOAGLUND was born in Japan to American missionary parents, and attended Japanese public schools. A graduate of Yale University, she has subtitled 200 Japanese films since 1996. Hoaglund produced and wrote the feature documentary film, *Wings of Defeat* (2007), about Kamikaze pilots who survived WWII, and *ANPO: Art X War* (2011), which tells the story of resistance to U.S. military bases in Japan.

Things Left Behind (2012) features an exhibition of color photographs of clothes and personal effects left behind by those who perished in the atomic bomb at Hiroshima, and explores the transformative power of the first major international art exhibit devoted to the atomic bomb. [80 min]
